I am not sure why we had more than usual online registration issues. In some cases, if your device had saved your sign in credentials from last year – some pages have been moved and links have been changed and so those appeared broken. A fresh sign-in seemed to resolve most issues.

Additionally, the payment processor that we use changed their platform in September and wasn't always compatible with our website so many of the attempts to make a payment on the website were disrupted. We have resolved this by changing the payment processor.

FEES ARE NOW PAST DUE

For this reason everyone is required to register online.

Please remember to mark the draw sheet with a W-L-T and consider entering this result on the website so you can track the results regularly. The curling club will update results after every square – so for more up to date tracking – please enter your own results.

FUNDRAISING

Fundraising is critical to the operation of the curling club. All of the building improvements, maintenance, staffing etc are paid from the fees you pay, the fundraising we do, and a few small grants that are still available to us. This is NOT a City of Edmonton facility, it is funded entirely by you, the members.

We have the following opportunities for fundraising in the curling club, and we ask you to participate as fully as you are able:

Casino – we will have a casino sometime in April, May or June of 2025 and will need about 40 volunteers. When you see the sign-up sheet – please consider volunteering.

Engraved beer mugs, wine glasses or curling rock handles – we will engrave your first name on a beer mug or wine glass for use in the curling club for a donation of \$125 or more. We will engrave your full name on a curling rock handle for a donation of \$200 or more. And of course you are always welcome to make a donation of any size, without etching your name anywhere.

Garage Sale – We will once again hold a garage sale in the arena April 25-27, 2025. We would love your donation of your no longer required items. As well, we need an army of volunteers to prepare and then sell your great unwanted treasures. This event has raised almost \$15,000 in each of the last two years and has become an important fund raising event for us.
